Push Notifications Setup Guide

Setting Up MT4 / MT5 Push Notifications on Your Phone

Push notifications are the most efficient way to track your charts without staring at your screen all day. Unlike SMS or Email alerts, push notifications are entirely **free, instant, and sent directly to your mobile device**.

The setup has two halves: your phone has to be allowed to show the alert, and your desktop terminal has to know which phone to send it to. The link between them is the **MetaQuotes ID**.

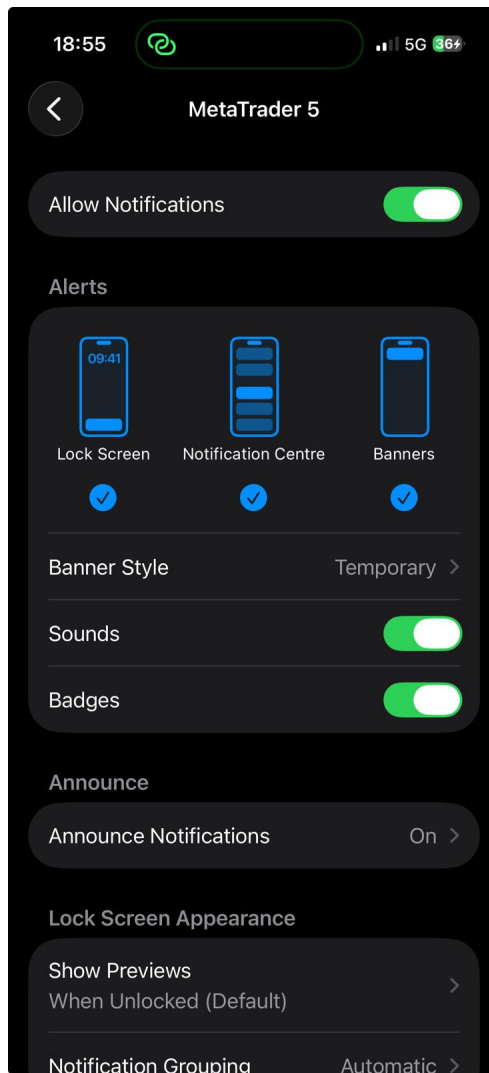
Mobile app → MetaQuotes ID → Desktop terminal → Push notification

1. Install MetaTrader and enable system permissions

Before configuring the app, you must ensure that your phone's operating system allows MetaTrader to display alerts.

On iPhone (iOS)

1. Open the **App Store**, search for **MetaTrader 4** or **MetaTrader 5**, and download the app.
2. Open your iPhone's system **Settings**.
3. Scroll down and tap **Notifications**, then find **MetaTrader 4** or **MetaTrader 5** in the list.
4. Turn on the **Allow Notifications** switch.
5. Make sure **Banners**, **Sounds** and **Badges** are all checked so you do not miss critical trade signals.

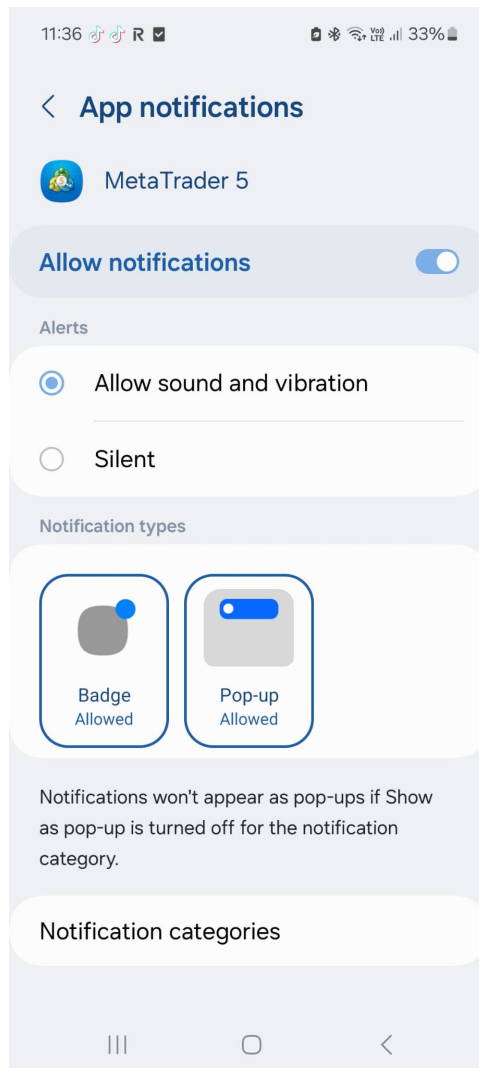

On Android

1. Open the **Google Play Store**, search for **MetaTrader 4** or **MetaTrader 5**, and download the app.
2. Open your Android device's system **Settings** and go to **Apps** (or **Apps & Notifications**).
3. Select **MetaTrader 4** or **MetaTrader 5** from the list and tap **Notifications**.
4. Make sure **Allow notifications** is toggled ON, with **Allow sound and vibration** selected.

Critical battery step: go back one screen to the app details, tap **Battery** (or **Battery Optimization**) and set it to **Unrestricted** (or **Don't Optimize**). This prevents Android from putting MetaTrader to sleep and delaying your alerts.



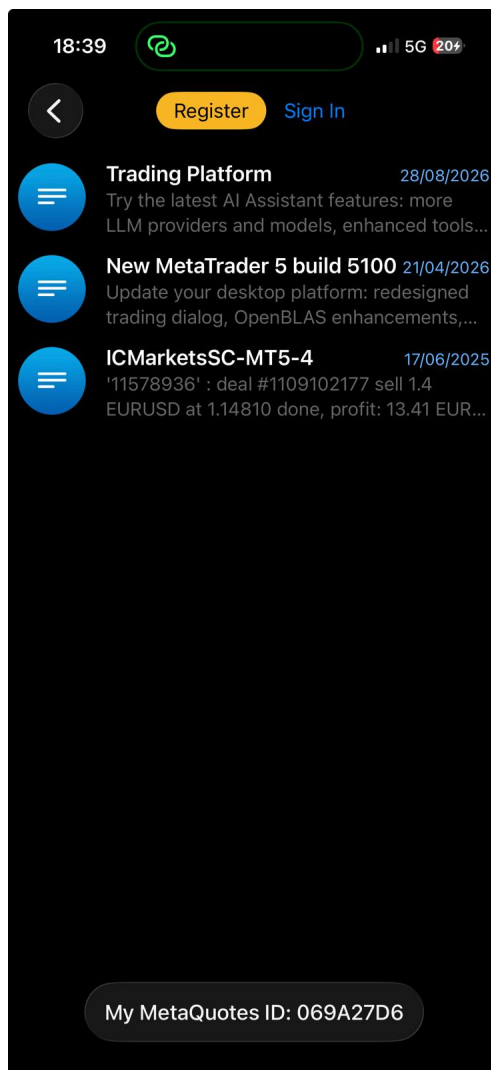
Screenshot 2 — Android > App notifications > MetaTrader 5: notifications allowed, with sound and vibration, badge and pop-ups

2. Locate and retrieve your MetaQuotes ID

The MetaQuotes ID is a unique 8-character code that links your desktop platform to your specific mobile device.

Finding the ID on iPhone (iOS)

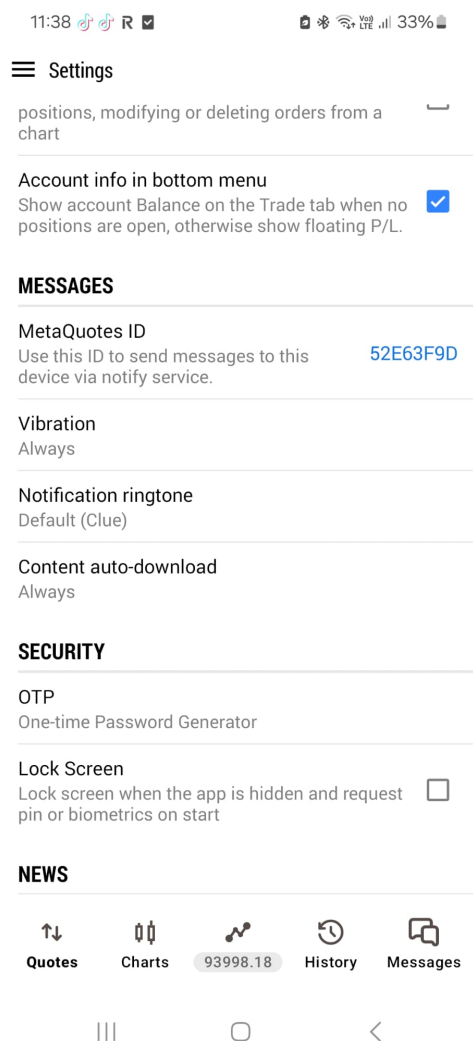
1. Open the mobile MT4 or MT5 app.
2. Tap the **Settings** icon (the gear symbol in the bottom-right corner).
3. Scroll down and tap **Messages**.
4. Look at the very bottom of the screen. You will see a line that reads **My MetaQuotes ID:** followed by a mix of 8 letters and numbers. Copy or write down this exact code.

Finding the ID on Android

1. Open the mobile MT4 or MT5 app.
2. Open the navigation sidebar by tapping the three horizontal lines (hamburger menu) in the top-left corner.
3. Tap **Settings** (gear icon).
4. Scroll down to the **MESSAGES** section.
5. Look for the label **MetaQuotes ID**. Next to it you will see your unique 8-character code.

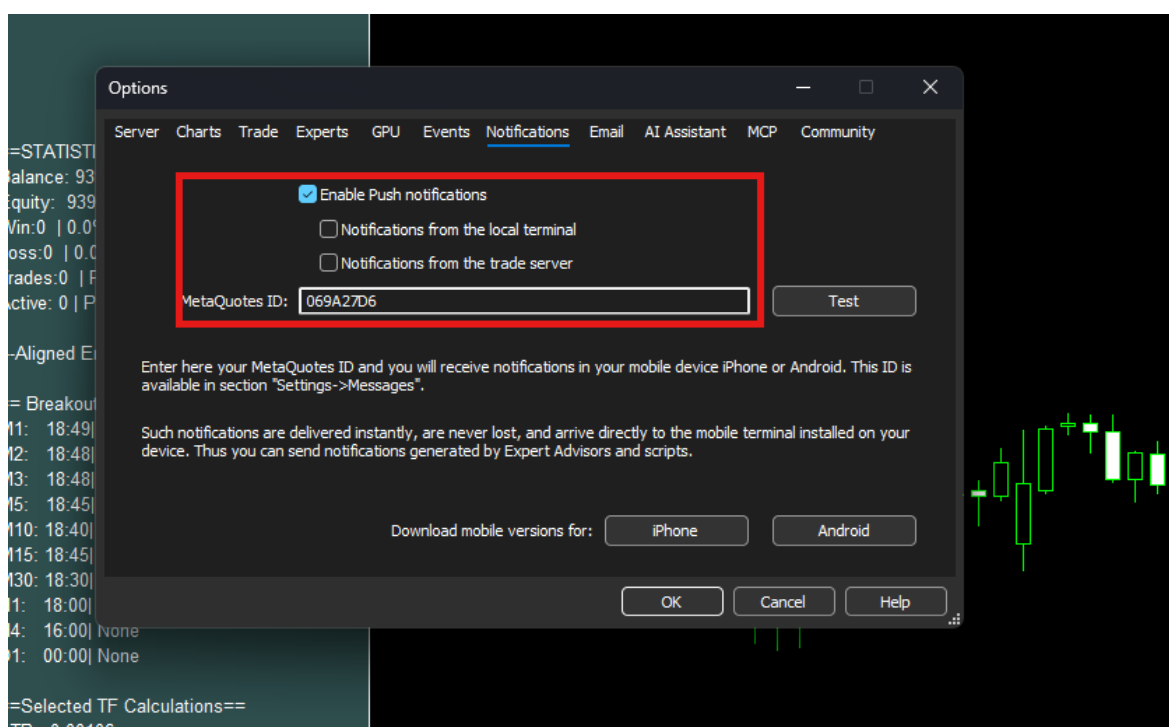


Screenshot 4 — Mobile MT5 on Android: MetaQuotes ID under the MESSAGES section

3. Link your desktop platform (MT4 or MT5)

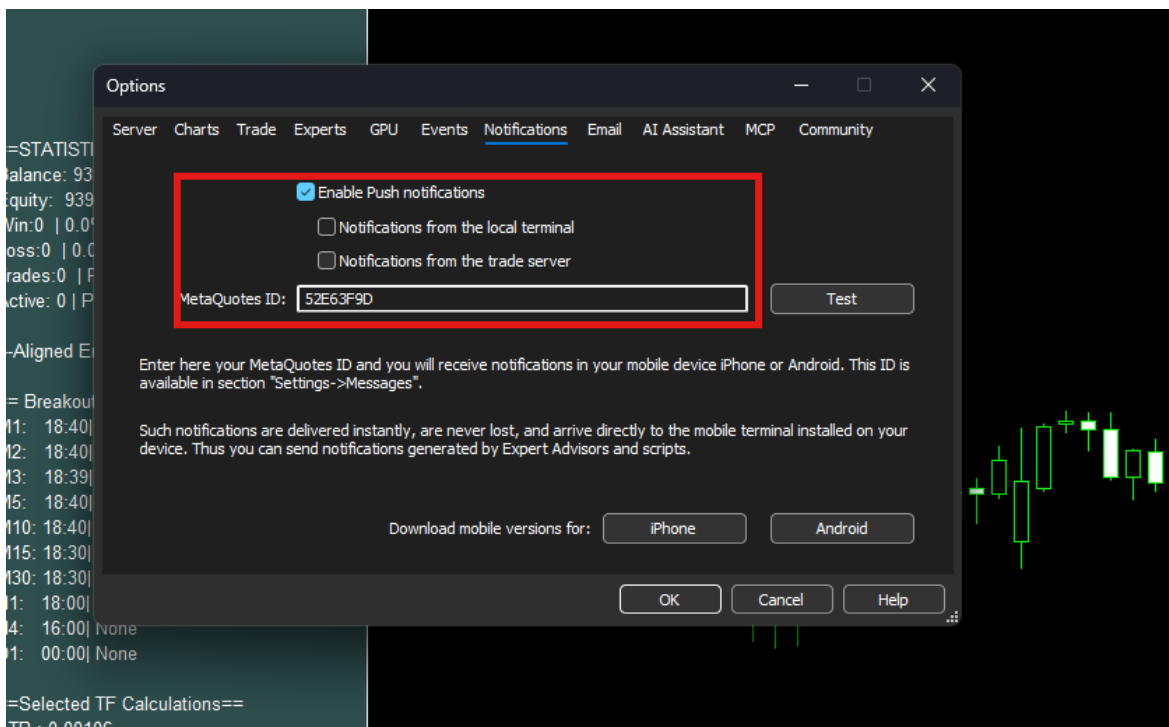
Now configure your desktop terminal to route alerts to your mobile phone.

1. Open your MT4 or MT5 desktop software on your PC or Mac.
2. In the top menu bar, click **Tools** → **Options** (or press **Ctrl + O**).
3. In the options window, open the **Notifications** tab.
4. Check **Enable Push notifications**.
5. Optionally check **Notifications from the trade server** for an instant alert every time a trade opens, closes, or hits a Stop Loss / Take Profit.
6. In the **MetaQuotes ID** field, type the exact 8-character code from Step 2.
7. Click **Test** to verify the connection.



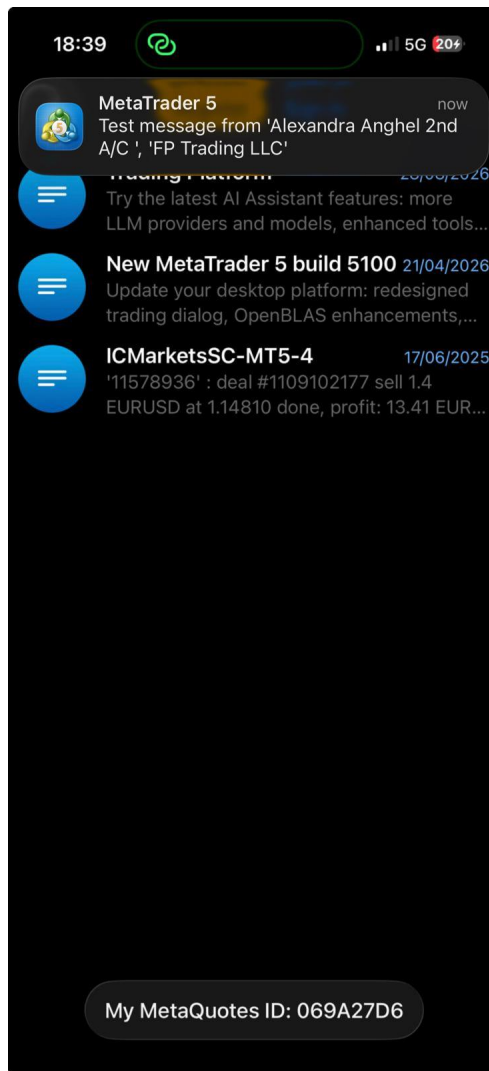

If you use a different phone, the same field takes that device's own code — one MetaQuotes ID links one phone.

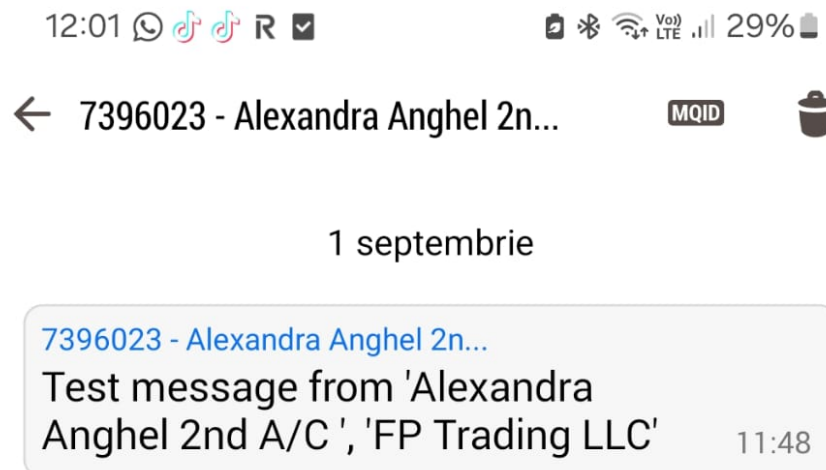


Screenshot 6 — The same tab with the Android MetaQuotes ID entered instead (red box)

Verification check: your phone should instantly buzz or display a notification reading "Test message from [Your Broker Name]". If the test message arrives, click **OK** at the bottom of the Options window to save your settings.

4. Create custom chart and indicator alerts

With the bridge established, you can now configure your trading tools to send messages to your phone.

Price alert setup (manual triggers)

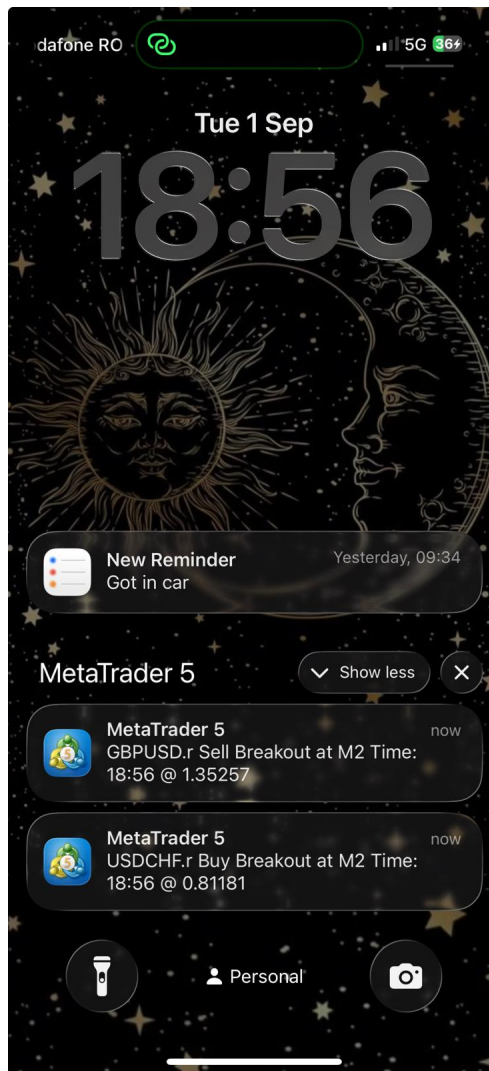
1. Right-click anywhere on your desktop chart at the price level you want to monitor.
2. Hover over **Trading** and click **Alert**.
3. A small red arrow appears on the right side of your chart. Double-click that arrow to open its settings.
4. Change the **Action** dropdown from **Sound** to **Notification**.
5. In the **Value** field, type your target execution price.
6. Click **OK**. When the market touches that price, your phone will ping.

Indicator / EA setup (automated triggers)

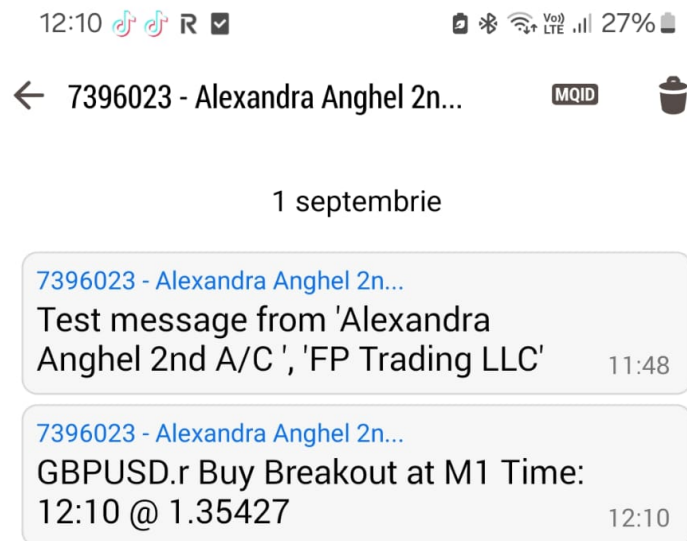
1. Load your technical indicator or Expert Advisor (such as **The Friendly PARTNER**) onto the chart.
2. Open its settings and go to the **Inputs** tab.
3. Locate the alert variables and change their values from **false** to **true**:

```
Send Push Notifications
Mobile Alerts
PushAlerts
```

Click **OK**, then make sure the **Algo Trading** button in your top MT4 / MT5 toolbar is lit up green. From that point on, every signal the toolkit generates is delivered to your phone.

5. Quick reference

Where	What to set
Phone — system settings	Allow Notifications ON (+ Battery Unrestricted on Android)
Mobile MT4 / MT5 app	Settings → Messages → copy the MetaQuotes ID
Desktop — Tools → Options	Notifications tab → Enable Push notifications + paste ID → Test
Chart alerts	Action = Notification
Indicator / EA	Push / Mobile alert inputs = true, Algo Trading ON

Important: one MetaQuotes ID links one phone. If you reinstall the app or change device, the ID changes — repeat Step 2 and Step 3 with the new code.
